The reporter is the manager of Stoney's, and asked us to assist her in removing the defendant from the property.</p> <p>As we approached the defendant he began to walk away from us. The reporter told the subject several times to come outside of the fenced in smoking area. The defendant ignored her requests as I also shouted verbal commands to exit the smoking area. The defendant ignored my commands as well so I attempted to get his attention with my flashlight.</p> <p>The defendant eventually approached our location, but refused to come outside of the fenced in area as ordered. When the defendant ignored my commands, I removed a plastic cup from his left hand that contained what appeared to be beer. I was able to gain control of his right arm while attempting to pull him over the fence. The defendant thrust his body backward in a forceful manner while pulling his arm from my grasp. I continued to shout commands for him to come over the fence; he replied "fuck you!" I was able to regain control of his right arm as Officer Ross assisted me in pulling the defendant over the fencing.</p> <p>Once over the fence, the defendant immediately rolled onto his back despite commands to roll onto his stomach. The defendant made attempts to raise his upper body off of the ground. I was able to keep the defendant on the ground by placing my right knee on his chest. The defendant began reaching for my face with both hands. I attempted to apply pressure at the brachial plexus clavicle notch to gain compliance. Officer Ross attempted to engage the defendant with his ECD, but he was not able to due to my close proximity to the defendant.</p> <p>The defendant eventually stopped reaching for my face, and we were able to roll him onto his stomach. I secured the defendant's left arm, while his right arm was under his body. Both Officer Ross and I gave numerous commands for the defendant to place his arm behind his back and he refused. Officer Ross had to forcefully pull the defendant's right arm from underneath his body. The defendant shouted "if you didn't have that badge and gun", but the defendant did not finish the rest of his comment. While the defendant shouted I attempted to keep him moving toward the car.
