As we were exiting our marked patrol car, we observed that there were 2 male occupants. The male in the passengers seat appeared to be looking for something in the center console area of the car. Both males told us that they were just turning around in the parking lot. Both subjects were having a difficult time paying attention and understanding our questions, because they were trying to listen to each others answers to our questions. We asked the males to exit the car. Officer Schafer asked the driver for consent to search, and verbal consent was given. Officer Schafer located a clear plastic baggie containing a green leafy substance in the side pocket of the drivers side door. Also in the side pocket was the driver's cell phone and wallet. Officer Schafer then located a clear plastic bubble wrap baggie containing a green leafy substance in the center console of the passenger car. I located a brownish colored hand rolled cigarette containing a green leafy substance. The baggies and the rolled cigarette were field tested for traces of THC by using the Duquenois levine Reagent Test # 908 and tested positive. The field weight totalled 1gm. Both the driver and the passenger were juveniles. Both the juveniles parents were notified by Officer Mattingly. Officers Mattingly and P. DeYoung transported both juvenile suspects to YCC.</p> <p>Enter Into Evidence: One sealed plastic bag containing two baggies of green leafy substance and one brownish handrolled cigarette with a green leafy substance.
