The odor of burnt marijuana in the living room was overwhelming. I peered under the couch and saw what I believed to be a glass smoking pipe. I retrieved the pipe, which was still warm. It had what appeared to be burnt marijuana residue inside it. The suspect then admitted that she stuffed the pipe under the couch. Another subject in the apartment was arrested for a small amount of marijuana as well. I cited the suspect for the pipe and it was entered into narcotics evidence. Citation issued # 8220033806.
