On arrival, Officers met with a woman who stated she had just received a call from an friend who stated that they were staying at the Sunset Motel in a room they got in her name. She stated that she believed they had to have stolen her ID in order to get the room. Officers asked her if she had her ID, and she stated that she did. They asked her how the people would have got a room in her name without her ID, and she stated that they may have returned it when they saw her earlier that evening. She asked that Officers check the hotel to verify that there was no room in her name, so she would not be held responsible for damages.<br><br>Officers arrived and found a room in the woman's name. Officers decided to go to the room to get the occupants side of the story. There was a male and a female staying in the room, and a female visiting. The male told Officers that his friend had gotten the room for him after helping him move, because he did not have an ID. The female staying with him also stated that the friend got the room for them, though she had her ID. Nobody in the room thought that the acquaintance was coming back to stay with them, since she has a place to stay. Officers told the female staying in the room to go to the front desk and put the room in her name. While Officers were waiting for her return, they observed, in plain view on the bed, a bottle of liquid fire, plastic tubing, cold packs, and an open blue bag with filters and other unknown items inside. Officers obtained consent to search from the two individuals who admitted to staying in the room. Inside the blue bag was more cold packs, salt, coffee filters, a blender, and mason jars. Inside a silver container on the table was a set of digital scales. There was a container of salt sitting underneath the television near the bed. There was aluminum foil next to the Bible in the nightstand.
