She said "mom", and the man took off running down the hall through the living room, and out the front door. All of the folks in the house awoke and they discussed the situation for a few minutes before calling the police. K9 Henderson attempted to track but was unable to locate a suspect. Demunbrun described the suspect as a black male 5ft 11in - 6ft 02in, 185-210lbs, very dark skin, a crazy afro with a part down the middle, wearing a white t-shirt and denim shorts. He was not wearing gloves. Nothing was taken from the house. There were two cars in the driveway. Both cars had the windows left down overnight and one had the keys left in the ignition. Nothing was taken from either vehicle except two CDs were removed from one and were lying on the ground next to the car. There was noticeable damage to the window screen to the bathroom window, and it was apparent that nearly every window of the house had been tampered with.
