I asked the suspect from the vehicle and advised him that I would be conducting Standard Field Sobriety Tests. I first tested the suspect on the gaze nystagmus. The suspect failed the test showing the lack of smooth pursuit, distinct sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation and onset of nystagmus prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. The suspect was then tested on the walk and turn. The suspect failed the test by stepping off the line during instructions, not walking heel to toe, raising his arms to keep his balance, not negotiating the turn as instructed and stopping the test before it was completed. The final test was the one leg stand. The suspect failed this test by raising his arms to keep his balance, dropping his foot three times, and stopped the test prior to being told to do so. The suspect was then tested on a PBT and showed a BrAC of .22% per 210 liters of breath. I advised the suspect of the results and placed him in handcuffs. I read the suspect the Indiana Implied Consent warning. The suspect did not give an answer on scene. I transported the suspect to the VCCC. Upon arrival, I tested the suspect on the BAC Datamaster inst#921059. I read the suspect the Indiana Implied Consent warning in the intoxilyzer room. The suspect submitted to the test.
