Dispatch attempted to call the caller back without any luck.</p> <p>While Officer A. Carlile and myself (N.Winsett) were enroute to the extra patrol, a motor vehicle accident was dispatched to Adams and Bedford. We decided to stop by the accident while enroute to the extra patrol. After arriving on scene, we saw a dark colored Chevy Impala four door vehicle with a black male driver passed out at the wheel and covered in blood. The vehicle had struck a parked truck and there was minimal damage done to both vehicles. After checking the driver of the vehicle (victim), we could tell he had some deep cuts on his throat and his left arm. It appears he did not sustain these injuries from the motor vehicle accident. The license plate on the Chevy Impala matched the plate (BN 8443) on the extra patrol that we were given moments earlier. It seems this was the vehicle that the original caller was following when the line disconnected.</p> <p>The victim was transported to St. Marys Hospital by A.M.R. (truck # 1538). While enroute to the hospital, the victim became combative and had to be physically restrained by myself. Once at the hospital he started passing out again due to blood loss. Detective K. Whitler was called to St. Mary's Hospital to speak with the victim. After he came back around, he told Det. Whitler that a tall, white, young, male attacked him with a knife. Det. Whitler advised the victim was not forthcoming with information at this time. Because he was being prepped for emergency surgery, no more information could be obtained about the suspect at this time.</p> <p>Dispatch advised the original caller on the extra patrol did not give his name or his vehicle information. They do however, have a cell phone number from the caller. The victim's vehicle was towed to the crime scene garage by Officer A. Fair and Officer K.
