I explained to the suspect the insurance card was expired so he took it back and then handed it back to me again. I then asked the suspect if he had anything to drink. The suspect said he had a couple beers with the last one being consumed around 2000hrs. I asked the suspect from the vehicle in order to conduct Standard Field Sobriety Tests(SFSTs). Reported: 06/04/2011.</p> <p>While on patrol in the parking lot of Stoney's (701 NW Riverside), I was flagged down by multiple groups of people about a vehicle that had been involved in several hit and runs. These individuals pointed in the direction of the Casino Aztar parking garage, and advised that the suspect vehicle fled in that direction. They described the vehicle as a black or grey Ford F-150.</p> <p>I was able to locate a vehicle matching that description traveling southwest on S. 3rd Ave toward Riverside. I activated my emergency lights and siren as the vehicle was coming to a stop at Riverside. The vehicle came to a stop, and then driver turned south onto Riverside in the north bound lane. After traveling several feet the driver drove over the curbed median, and then pulled into the north entrance of Casino Aztar. The driver stopped the vehicle shortly after making the turn.</p> <p>As I exited my vehicle, the driver of the truck also exited without being told to do so. As the driver exited a glass bottle fell from his lap and busted on the concrete. The driver immediately began walking toward me as I shouted at him to stop and put his hands behind his back. The driver ignored my commands as he continued to walk toward me at a fast pace. I drew my ECD and pointed it at the driver while giving him commands.</p> <p>The driver stopped as he was approximately three to four feet from me and took an aggressive stance as he balled his fists. I continued to give him commands to place his hands behind his back but he refused. I deployed my ECD serial number X00-429361, cartridge number C41009EM6 striking the driver in the chest. The driver fell to the ground and I gave him commands to roll onto his stomach. The driver was on his right side, and refused to go onto his stomach as instructed. I told the driver that I would activate my ECD again if he refused to comply. At that time Officer Oakley arrived and was able to handcuff the driver. The driver did not place his hands behind his back as instructed, and Officer Oakley was forced to physically pull the drivers hands behind his back.</p> <p>While searching the driver he asked me several times "what is going on?" As he spoke I could smell a very strong odor of alcoholic beverages coming from his breath, and his speech was slurred. His eyes were bloodshot and glassy as well. He stated that he had consumed "a few beers" during the night.</p> <p>As I secured the driver's property, a subject walked up to me and advised that he was nearly struck the suspect vehicle as he walked through the parking lot of Stoney's. There were also numerous other people walking through the lot at the time the driver drove through the lot. His information was taken, and added to the report.</p> <p>The driver was identified as the defendant _____, and his driver's status was found to be suspended out of Kentucky. Other officers were able to locate the victim of the hit and run, and completed a hit and run report. There was damage on the suspect vehicle that was consistent with the damage to the victim's vehicle. The damage to the suspect vehicle consisted of dents and scratches down the entire passenger side.</p> <p>I was not able to complete SFSTs due to the driver's uncooperative state. He also refused a portable breath test. While being transported to the jail the defendant kept repeating the phrase "I shoulda` shot that mother fucker right in the face." Although no guns were found on the defendant or in the vehicle, he advised me that he has numerous guns that are registered in his brothers name. He also added that he knows he is not allowed to possess firearms because he is a convicted felon.</p> <p>After arriving at the jail the defendant was told to step out of the vehicle. I secured the defendant's right arm as we walked toward the interlock area. The defendant forcefully pulled his arm away from my grasp as he walked away from me. I attempted to regain control of the defendants arm but he continued to move away from me. The defendant lost his balance on a raised curb in the sally port, and fell against the wall. I regained control of the defendant as we got to the interlock door. The defendant pulled away from me again and he was taken to the ground. He was placed in the restraint chair due to his uncooperative state. Based on the defendant's actions we were not able to complete any SFST's or chemical breath tests. The victim said, "He was really going to hurt me bad and stopped only because he saw police lights over here."</p> <p>We went to the victim's apartment and found the door unlocked and open. The victim's two children were asleep in the back bedroom. The victim's son is 2 years old (IO) and the offender is the biological father. The victim and offender have just recently ended their relationship and in the past did live together.</p> <p>Officer's cleared the apartment and were unable to locate the offender inside. K9 Officer Matthews was called and he attempted to track but was unable to locate the offender on the property of Vann Park Apts. The victim was very upset and complained of pain to her neck. The victim said she did not need an ambulance. I could not see any visible marks on the victim's neck. However, Officer Harrington and I both did notice that the skin on her neck was a bit more red than the rest of her skin. The victim was shaking with fear.</p> <p>Officer's questioned the victim and she said that the the offender can not accept that the relationship is over. When he returned his vehicle was gone. The vehicle was a maroon 1995 Chevy Camero with the T-tops removed. The key was broken off in the ignition, however the victim had the half of the key that contained the security chip. The victim stated that he didn't think the vehicle would start without the chip, so it is unknown how the vehicle would have gotten started. Additionally, the victim stated that the vehicle had very little gas in the tank. I had dispatch contact all of the local towing services to ensure that the vehicle hadn't been towed. The victim stated that he is the only one with a key and that he did not have a lien on the vehicle.</p> <p>The witness was outside her house and saw two young thin white males trying to get into cars along her street during the same timeframe that the victim's vehicle was stolen. She could not provide any further description of the suspects. She stated they ran off when they saw her.</p> <p>****Update****</p> <p>While finishing this report, the witness called back to report that the listed suspects returned to the neighborhood in the stolen vehicle. The suspects then fled in another unknown dark colored vehicle east from the scene.</p> <p>The victim's vehicle was left in the alley between Oregon and Maryland, just east of Read Street.
