I asked the driver for his license, registration, and proof of insurance and he provided it. Officer Schafer arrived to assist. I asked the driver to exit and he complied. I asked him if there was any marijuana in the vehicle and he said there wasn't. I checked his pockets and didn't locate any contraband. Officer Schafer spoke to the front seat passenger. Officer Schaffer asked him if he had anything illegal on his person. He removed his cigarette package and opened it; inside was a small plastic bag containing a plant material that I recognized to be marijuana from my law enforcement training and experience. I took possession of the plant material from Officer Schafer and submitted it as evidence at the Evansville Police Department. The back seat passenger was searched by Officer S. Dutschke and nothing illegal was found on her.</p> <p>The driver gave me permission to search the car, and nothing illegal was found inside. The front seat passenger was issued an information and summons for possession of marijuana. I told him his court date was on January 31, 12 at 08:30am and he was required to appear. He said he understood. When officers entered the home there were numerous dogs that were emaciated and had not eaten for days. Several of the animals were in such bad condition that you could see every bone in there body. It was very difficult to determine how many animals were in the house do to the confined space and several of the animals being locked in different rooms. One of the animals a small Dotson was so emaciated the you could see all of the bones in its body including the hip and leg bones. When the owner(OF 3) of the animal was questioned about the health of the Dotson she stated that he was on a special diet. There was another smaller white dog with a large tumor on its right back leg and it was also emaciated to the point that it had problems walking. When the owners(OF 4&5) of the animal that was attacked was questioned where and when the attack occurred they stated that it occurred at 306 N Tekoppel late in the night of 11/26/11 and they had already taken the animals remains to Titzer Funeral home to be cremated. I then asked to see the home at the address of 306 N Tekoppel to see where the attack had happened and the (OF 1) then took me across the street to see. When I opened the front door I was immediatly overwhelmed by the strong smell of ammonia. I then stepped inside and had to leave the house to get fresh air. The animals that were staying at this address had free run of the entire house. The house was covered in feces and urine and had not been cleaned for weeks. There were no animals found at this property. There were also two animals staying in the garage that were chained to the wall, and the were emaciated as well. The owner(OF 2) of those two animals lives out in the garage and claimed that he feeds them on a regular basis. It was clear that none of these animals had been taken or treated by a vet.

There was very little food in the bag and officers poured the remainder of the food on the floor for the animals to eat. When officers did so the animals went into a feeding frenzy as if they had not eaten for days. The dogs were literally fighting over the food. When I asked the offenders why the dogs looked like this they would state they were eating and they were simply not putting on any weight. The property had dog urine and feces on the floor in every room and the smell of ammonia was overwhelming. The floors were turning black from where the feces was not cleaned up properly. The kitchen looked like it had not been cleaned in a few months the dishes were piled up on the counter and the sink at least one foot high and had old molded food and trash with roaches and maggots in them. Every surface in the house was dirty and had roaches climbing on it. There was little to no eatable food in the house.
