When we pulled up the victim told us that he was hit in the head with a hammer by his wife at 1116 Georgia St.</p> <p>The victim told us that his wife (suspect) had been drinking heavily earlier in the night and started to become angry and aggressive so he left and walked down to the convenience store at the corner of Fulton and Georgia to give her time to calm down. After a couple hours the victim went back home, and at that time both the victim and the suspect ended up outside. Both subjects were arguing, and the suspect grabbed the victims phone and both ended up on the ground wrestling over the phone.</p> <p>The suspect told us the both walked up to the house and the suspect went inside first and when the victim started to go inside the suspect closed the door on him. The victim told me that he turned the knob and pushed the door open. When he got inside the suspect grabbed a hammer and swung it at him hitting him in the arm area, and after a few swings hit him in the top part of the head causing a very small cut. The victim told me that after they wrestled around for a few minutes that they both sat down to try to work things out. The suspect started getting angry again so the victim told me that he then walked down to Fulton Ave., trying to flag down cars to call the police.</p> <p>We then called for a AMR to check the victims head, and while AMR was checking the victim, we spoke with the suspect. The suspect told us a completely different story that the victim had busted in the front door and picked up the hammer and started swinging it violently striking himself in the head, and also hitting her in the head causing a small contusion to the top of the forehead.</p> <p>Both parties told us different stories about what had really happened, and neither the suspect or victim wanted to pursue charges on the other. AMR was called for the victim and told us he had a very small cut to his head and needed no other medical attention. The suspect wasn't sure if she was going to the hospital or not.</p>	OAKLEY, J.
