She identified the listed offenders as those people. Officer Taylor spoke with the offenders who were completely cooperative. The offenders stated that the victim had approached and sat her drink on their table. They further stated that another female who was sitting at the table asked the victim to remove her drink, due to the fact that they had paid for the table as part of the New Years celebration. They further stated that the victim became belligerent with the female when she was asked to remove the drink. After some words were exchanged the victim threw a beer bottle at the female and grabbed the other female by the hair starting a fight. The offenders stated that "a blonde female", who is believed to be the victims sister, then jumped in and began punching the other female. The offenders stated that they attempted to break the fight up. The male offender

The fight can be seen going on in the video, However due to the massive crowd of people inside the bar and in that particular area it was impossible to tell what started the fight or tell if anyone was struck. One of the civilian security officers working the club stated that he did see the victim throw a beer bottle in the direction of the table the offenders were at. As he started toward the area he was unable to see anything else until he was able to push through the crowd to get to the fight.  A report was completed at the request of the victim. She was advised of the procedure to receive a copy of the report and advised of the procedure to follow up with the prosecutors office if she wished to attempt to pursue charges.
