The subject stated that there were multiple hackers from both inside and outside of the United States. The subject stated he could block the hackers from inside the U.S. but that he would not be able to do it from the ones in Mexico, Cuba, and the Bahamas. The subject told Carolyn that in order to block the hackers from out of the Country it would cost 50 dollars for each of these countries. The subject stated she would need to purchase 3 Google cards totally \$150 dollars and that he would need the card numbers once she got them. Carolyn stated she did go and purchase the cards at a local Walgreens and gave the subject the information on the back. Carolyn stated she became suspicious but that the subject assured her that she would need to go and purchase 2 more Google cards, which she reluctantly did, so that these hackers could also be blocked. Carolyn stated the longer the two continued to talk the more money this subject tried og et out of her. Carolyn stated she has since taken the proper steps to secure her accounts.	Officer
