IO1 stated that she was sitting inside of her home while talking on the phone, and heard someone using a key to open her door. IO1 stated that she was startled by this, because according to her no one should have a key to her residence. IO1 stated that the person who entered into her home was IO2, who is also the father of her son. IO1 stated that when IO2 entered the home, he immediately approached her in an aggressive manner and attempted to take her phone away from her.

IO1 stated that they began to wrestle each other over the phone. IO1 stated that IO2 eventually overpowered her and took possession of her phone. IO1 stated that once her phone was taken away from her, she went into her son's bedroom and removed him from his bed. IO1 stated that she attempted to leave with her son, but IO2 grabbed her by the face and would not allow her to leave the residence. IO1 stated that when IO3 realized that 911 had been called, he fled from her residence.

IO1 stated the IO2 made a copy of her key without her knowledge. IO1 stated that IO2 does come over from time to time, but she stated that she has to allow him into the home. IO1 stated that IO2 was to meet her earlier today to get some items that he had left in her residence. IO1 stated that IO2 was supposed to wait on her to allow him inside of the residence. IO1 stated that IO2 stated to her that he would find a way to get inside of the residence. IO1 stated that when she arrived to her residence, IO2 was inside. IO1 stated that she was upset, because she had no idea how IO2 got inside of the residence. IO1 stated that she would often have IO2 come to her job to get the key for her home so that he could gain entry. IO1 stated that she never gave IO2 permission to have a key made to her residence.
