The caller reported a black female had stolen merchandise and was last seen leaving in a blue Ford passenger car. Officers arrived on scene and met with the caller, he is identified as the reporting party. He stated a fellow loss prevention employee, identified as the witness, had a black female steal merchandise and flee from her. Officers entered the loss prevention office and spoke with the witness. She reported two black females, one described as the offender, entered the business through the "Juniors" doors on the southeast side of the building. She reported the offender had a large and flat bag on her shoulder and walked toward the children & infant clothing area while the other female went elsewhere. She watched the offender via surveillance equipment and observed her select numerous children and infant clothing items. She walked near shoes, bent down and her purse strap was reportedly observed leaving her shoulder. The bag now appeared fuller and bulkier than it previously had as the offender selected additional items. At some point, the offender walked to the bathroom while her friend / acquaintance purchased items. A short time later, the two left through the "Juniors" doors and were approached by loss prevention, the witness and the reporting party. The witness stated she identified herself and reported the offender told her something along the lines, she was not going to cooperate. The reporting party stated he walked away to call 9-1-1 after he heard the offender state she was going to be uncooperative. The witness reported the offender somewhat shoved her with her purse and fled south / southwest toward the former "Toys-R-Us" parking lot. Loss prevention followed and observed the females enter a blue Ford passenger car. They were last seen headed west / southwest toward Congress Avenue. The offender was described as an older black female with a thick build. She was believed to be approximately 40-50 years of age and weighed approximately 170-210 pounds.
