she raised her hands at the other driver in a gesture of, "What's the problem?" She continued on Fairway Drive and noted the suspect vehicle turned around. The suspect vehicle followed her to the intersection of Fairway Drive / N First Avenue where she stopped for the stop sign, waiting for traffic to clear. She reported the suspect vehicle drove over the curb, onto the sidewalk and stopped on the passenger side of her vehicle to yell at her. She again raised her arms in a gesture of, "What's your problem?" She stated the suspect opened her driver's door at least twice and intentionally struck her vehicle, a white 2015 Mitsubishi Outlander, on the passenger side, leaving several dents and scrapes with paint transfer. The suspect was last seen driving over additional parking stops into the parking lot of the Ivy Tech Bookstore. She and her passenger were able to obtain a partial Indiana license plate, "SPY811".

The offender was described as a white female with a heavy build, approximately 30-40 years of age with short blonde hair.

As officers were working on the report, the victim returned to the scene and reported she located the suspect's vehicle parked at 3204 Tremont Road, noting it was backed in and she observed marks on the driver's door of the vehicle consistent with damage to her vehicle.

Officers arrived at 3204 Tremont Road and located the above suspect vehicle, identified as a gray / taupe 2004 Ford Explorer, with damage to the driver's door. Officers made contact at the residence and spoke with a white female, later identified as the offender, who matched the description given by the victim. The offender stated she wanted to speak with officers and admitted to everything, which corroborated the victim's statements. She stated her emotions got the best of her and regretted her actions.

The offender's actions were intentional, which meant the incident did not require an accident report. The offender was given a misdemeanor citation / summons and ordered to appear in court for her actions. No arrest was made.
