Reported: 11/19/2019.</p> <p>The suspect and V1 have a child in common and they have been involved in a romantic relationship. Recently, the suspect and V1 decided to separate. At approximately 0500 hours, V1 and the suspect began having a verbal argument through telephone and text message. Eventually, the suspect arrived at V1`s apartment where her sister (V2) and her sister`s boyfriend (IO1) were present. The suspect began to turn the doorknob, but the door was locked. A gasoline can was outside of V1`s apartment which contained an unknown amount of gasoline. The suspect poured gasoline from that can onto the apartment windows, door, and outdoor furniture.</p> <p>The gasoline had evaporated by the time I arrived, but I could see where the gasoline had been poured in several places, and it had damaged the paint on the door. Some of the gasoline that the suspect poured onto the door ran down the outside of the door and then inside of the apartment onto the floor. I could see where the gasoline had dried on the floor on the inside of the apartment, and I observed the strong odor of gasoline both inside and outside of the apartment. The suspect`s actions created a risk of injury or death for all residents of the apartment building because of how quickly a fire could spread if the gasoline were to come in contact with an ignition source.</p> <p>While the suspect was at the apartment, V1 received a call on her cellphone from the suspect`s phone. V1 has the suspect`s phone number blocked which resulted in the call being routed directly to voicemail. During the call, voicemail recorded the suspect threatening the victims. V1 played the voicemail back for me and I heard the suspect say "I`ll burn you up bitch. I promise to God. I`ll burn both of you." None of the parties could advise if the suspect was armed with any ignition sources at the time that he poured the gasoline.</p> <p>Once V1 opened the door, she and V2 observed the suspect standing at the corner of the building. The suspect stated, "come around the corner and I`ll pop both of ya`ll". Both victims observed the suspect reaching into his waistband area as if he was armed with a firearm while making this statement, and both victims were fearful that the suspect may shoot them.</p> <p>The suspect fled the area before my arrival. The victims indicated that they were familiar with how to obtain a protective order and requested extra patrol.
