Assessor, Vanderburgh County	435-5179	Assesses persons and property and the discovery and assessment of property, makings lists and returns.
Auditor, Vanderburgh County	435-5763	County Controller. Keeps ledgers and records affecting County funds; receiving and disbursing.
Building Authority	435-5801	Operation and maintenance of Evansville-Vanderburgh County buildings.
