For Immediate Release: Winnecke Announces Transition Team

Mayor-Elect Lloyd Winnecke officially launched “Transition Evansville” today to bring together the best and the brightest to guide his administration as he prepares to take office on January 1. Winnecke’s 15-person transition team includes a mixture of government experts with knowledge of departments, as well as many business and non-profit outsiders.

The full list can be found below, and also on a new website created for the effort at www.TransitionEvansville.com. “I wanted it to be different from the same people we’ve seen in other transition teams – people who can take a fresh look at these things,” said Winnecke. “Everybody on this team has a different perspective.”

In the coming days the Transition Team will be posting requests for applicants for specific positions. In the interim it is accepting resumes generally. Those interested in serving in the administration may apply by submitting an application online at www.TransitionEvansville.com. All resumes must be received by November 25th.

During the campaign Winnecke said he would replace the current police and fire chief, and likely other key positions. “I hope that I can have some key personnel decisions announced within the next month,” he said.

Winnecke encouraged talented prospects to consider a career in public service. “This is a unique time in our city’s future. It’s a chance to make a new, fresh start. And that means bringing in talent and energy that we usually don’t see in public service.”
