I checked the area along with the RP. The RP stated that as he was attempting to catch up with the suspect, the suspect turned left into the Sunrise East Apts, where he lost sight of them. The RP thinks that he either ran in to an apartment, or cut through the back side of the apartments on the east side of the back apartments (there is a small pass-way that he could have fled through). I then took the RP back to Buy-Low. On the way back, the RP pointed out a glass jar of Lay's Ranch Dip that the suspect had taken but dropped when he was trying to get away from the RP. The ranch dip was the only item that they are aware of that was destroyed or was not recovered. The RP stated that there is video surveillance and will have the manager get a copy to us.
