He said he contacted Schiff and told him he was not going to be able to pay the monthly contract payment due to his benefits being lost. Damrath said Schiff was understanding and said he would allow him to stay for a period of time without paying. Damrath said in the meantime he decided to stay at another residence he owns in Kentucky. He said he moved some of his property to this location, but still had a good amount of property at the 200 Missouri St. address. Damrath said on 011215 someone had broken into the house by forcing open the back door. At the time when the police were there he could not find anything missing. Damrath said approximately two weeks ago he told Schiff he had been staying at another residence of his in Kentucky, and said he still had property in the 200 Missouri St address. He told Schiff he would try to get the rest of his property out soon. Damrath said Schiff was fine with that. On 020815 1100 hours Damrath said he went to the Missouri address and discovered some of his property had been discarded in the back yard. He said some of the property had been damaged. He said a portable drill, an indoor tree, and truck parts were all damaged. Damrath also said other items were missing from the inside of the house. He assumes they have been thrown away. He said he has tried to contact Schiff, but cannot get an answer. Damrath tried to call Schiff twice while I was there and got his voicemail both times. Damrath said there has not been an eviction and possibly, if his benefits gets reinstated, that he would keep the house on Missouri St. Schiff has not taken any civil legal action against Damrath. Damrath said he has saved all the texts between he and Schiff, and thinks Schiff did not have the right to enter the residence and throw out his property. I advised Damrath I would take a report and gave him the case number.
