Reported: 03/27/2015.</p> <p>On 03/27/2015 at approximately 0112 hours, I was traveling west on Pollack Ave when I observed a red passenger car (Lic#WSC174) in front of me without properly working turn signals. The vehicle was turning south onto Burdette Ave from Pollack Ave and the turn signal lit up but did not operate properly. I initiated a traffic stop of the vehicle on Burdette Ave just south of Pollack Ave and made contact with the driver, identified as W. Bentle. As I was talking to Bentle I observed the strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. I asked Bentle when was the last time someone smoked marijuana inside the vehicle and he stated that he may have earlier when he got off work. At that time I returned to my fully marked patrol vehicle to run Bentle's information through my in car computer and Officer D. Kemmerer arrived to assist. I advised Ofc. Kemmerer what I had observed as far as the odor of marijuana. I approached the vehicle and asked Bentle to exit the vehicle for me, which he did. I asked Bentle if there was anything else inside his vehicle and he told me that he had a pipe that he used to smoke with earlier. I asked him if there was any marijuana inside the vehicle and he said he had a small amount in there. I asked him where it would be at and he told me either on the floor or in the center console. Due to the odor of marijuana a search of the vehicle was conducted and a small amount of marijuana and a pipe used to ingest narcotics into the body was located inside the center console (which is where Bentle stated I would locate the narcotics and paraphernalia). The marijuana had a field weight of 4 grams and tested positive for THC using a 908 Duquenois-Levine reagent test kit. Bentle was cited for the possession of marijuana and paraphernalia and released from the stop. Ziemer had to be told numerous times to remain seated. Ziemer became increasingly agitated, shouting "fuck you" to the officers on scene, and was placed in handcuffs. Officer Bourland and I escorted Ziemer to the rear of my patrol vehicle when he nearly fell several times, while Officer Hassler went to Helfrich Golf Course to find the complainant.</p> <p>Officer Hassler made contact with employees of Helfrich Golf Course, Brian Rose and John Marklin. According to the employees, this was Ziemer's third day of employment. Today, Ziemer was dropped off at Helfrich Golf Course by another individual; however, employees said he could hardly stand and made no sense when he was speaking due to his level of intoxication. He became aggressive and left the location when employees phoned 911 believing Ziemer needed medical attention. While at the golf course, Officer Hassler collected Ziemer's belongings including a large portable intoxilyzer machine which Ziemer is to take with him and "blow into" at various times.</p> <p>Ziemer was taken to Deaconess Hospital where he was cleared for jail admittance. He continued to be belligerent with all EPD officers, as well as Deaconess staff. Again, he refused to cooperate with medical professionals.
