Myers became concerned that his next door neighbor Dickson was using him as a patsy in some sort of ID Theft scheme so that is why he filed 15-07720 which he said he did "to clear his name." He stated he tried to talk to Dickson about it but she kept putting him off and telling him not to worry about it.</p> <p>EPD Sergeant Craig Jordan of Financial Crimes unit obtained a contact number for Tammy J. Bunce of Niagra NY, and spoke with her. She confirmed it was her that had called Myers and stated that on 04/13/15 she had found out via a letter from Home Depot that a set of night vision binoculars and a home security system had been purchased online in her name. The letter was assuming she had actually ordered it and thanking her for her business, etc. She called Home Depot and found out where it had been shipped and from there tracked down Myers and called him, as Myers had reported later. Bunce indicated to Sgt Jordan her personal information might have been comprised in a data breach and used to committ ID Theft against her by setting up an account with Home Depot and ordering items online.</p> <p>During the time frame involved here, Marilyn Dickson was wanted on felony warrants stemming from a prior incident wherein she cooperated in an identity theft scheme committed online against an out of state subject who had over \$15,000 stolen from his investment account. In that case, Dickson had received the stolen funds and deposited them into her local bank account pending receipt of instructions from her handlers on when and where to send the funds, that was case #14-23142 investigated by Det Wies of EPD Financial Crime Unit and had occurred through the months of February and March 2014. Prior to that case, EPD Financial Crimes Unit detectives Tim Bickel and Joey Weigant had investigated Dickson for recieving merchandise bought online by hackers using stolen credit card numbers where she was cooperating with the fraudsters by re-labeling the packages for shipment outside of the continental United States. She was not charged at that time because she claimed she didn't know she was cooperating with an off shore criminal syndicate, but the nature of such internet schemes was thoroughly explained to her by Bickel and Weigant who also issued her a warning not to participate in those sorts of arrangments again or be in jeopardy of arrest if there was a next time.</p> <p>On 04/18/15 Tammy J Bunce filed # NF-013909-15 with Niagra Falls NY Police Department for ID Theft and Larceny.
