| <i>Incident Rpt Misc</i> | <p>Myself and Officer J. Lowe were traveling east on Louisiana St. Between Read and Baker, we could smell the odor associated with the manufacture of methamphetamine. We drove back through and parked at Louisiana and Read.</p> <p>Officers Oakley and Underwood arrived to assist. Myself and Officer Oakley walked east on Louisiana and Officers Lowe and Underwood walked down the alley between Louisiana and Missouri. Myself and Officer Oakley could smell the odor around 122 and 124 W. Louisiana St. There was a light on in the back yard of 124 W. Louisiana. Officers Lowe and Underwood could see a male through the window in the back of the house. They could see him moving around. I walked between 122 and 124 to the back of the house. I could still smell the odor but not as strong. I could hear the male moving around. It sounded like he was using plastic and tape.</p> <p>I had called dispatch to check the history on 124 W. Louisiana St. They advised there had been involvement with Goodmon on the 6th of March. Austin has prior history with methamphetamine.</p> <p>Sgt. Thompson arrived on scene. It was decided to do a knock and talk. I began knocking on the door. Officer A. Kennedy was looking through the window of the front door and could see a female on the floor trying to hide behind a chair. I continued knocking and yelled it was the police. Officer Kennedy saw the female take a juvenile female from the front room to the back of the house. We were given permission to make entry. Officer Oakley began kicking the front door. Officers still announcing it was the police. A light came on and Officer Kennedy to the male it was the police and to open the door. The male opened the door. He had a plastic bag in his hand. He was placed in cuffs. There was another male in the bedroom off of the living room. The female and juvenile were in the bathroom. The occupants were removed from the house and JTF was contacted.</p> <p>I waited at the back of the house until consent was given or warrant was obtained.</p> <p>Detective Erk arrived on scene and consent was given. After both males, who live at the address, signed the consent, Detective Erk began the search. He found ground charcoal, containers of Mrs. Stewarts bluing liquid, 2 boxes of cold packs. The cold packs had been torn apart. In the bathroom was two fish bowls with blue liquid and the toilet was stained blue.</p> <p>There was a locked closet door.
