He said on 041315 around 2245 hours suspect #1 knocked on his door and asked if she could hang out there because she was fighting with her boyfriend. Cote said he does not know suspect #1's boyfriend's name, but she calls him "Len". According to Cote, after suspect #1 entered the apartment Len was walking up and down the alley next to the apartment. Cote said he allowed suspect #1 to stay to keep her safe. Cote said around 0445 hours suspect #1 texted Len and told him Cote was beating her up. Cote said he never laid a hand on her, but within a few minutes he heard knocking on the apartment door. He said he heard suspect #1 let Len inside the apartment. Cote said a short time later he asked suspect #1 and Len to leave. He said Len started to get aggressive and acted like he was going to fight him. Cote said he was able to leave the apartment around 0600 hours. He said when he walked out of the apartment he observed suspect #2 sitting in a car in the alley. Cote said suspect #2 told him to tell suspect #1 and Len he was there to pick them up.
