He fumbled getting his license out of his wallet several times and could not find his registration. A county unit arrived to assist and they located his registration.	
	When I attempted to preform the SFST with the defendant, he informed me that he has Cerebal Palsey and would be unable to complete the tests. I asked him to recite the alphabet. He could not recite it correctly even after being given two chances. The first time he stopped after the letter P and the second he stopped after the letter T. I demonstrated the finger count test twice. He stated that he	
	understood the test. He touched the correct fingers, but did not count correctly. He counted "1-2-3-4-3-1-2". He was offered a PBT which indicated a BAC of 0.208. He was read the implied consent card and agreed to take the test.	
	During the ride to the jail, he fell asleep in the rear of my car. While getting out of the car, he vomited. Officer Kennedy was operating the certified test. While waiting for the mandated 20 minutes to pass after the 1st vomiting, the defendant vomited again. Another 20 minutes. Officer Kennedy was able to get a good test on the defendant.
