Carter-Vasquez phoned 911 stating that he dropped off his girlfriend's vehicle at Shoe Carnival on the west side. He claimed his girlfriend (whom he has lived with and shares a child) told him that she filed the vehicle as stolen. The vehicle was not reported stolen; however, there was an active BOL on the vehicle for an unauthorized control.

During our discussion via telephone, he elaborated that there had been a physical altercation the previous day. Carter-Vasquez said he usually drove the Trailblazer, which is registered to his girlfriend, to work at Azteca. Yesterday, he said his girlfriend decided that she wanted the truck. He told her he was taking the truck anyway because he needed to get to work. At that point, Carter-Vasquez said she threatened to call police and report the vehicle stolen. Carter-Vasquez admitted to taking her cell phone at that time and leaving the area, but said that he told her to follow him to another location so they could talk. Carter-Vasquez said he pulled over near Franklin and Barker prior to arriving at the agreed upon location, but that his girlfriend shoved him to get into the truck. He said he pushed her back and she fell to the ground. He said he tried to help her up; however, she got to the vehicle and tried to take the keys and struck him several times in the face. He said he had minor injuries to his face. He wished to document this incident. Today, Carter-Vasquez said he received a text message from his girlfriend stating she had obtained a protective order, but he had not yet been served with one.
