Upon speaking to the driver of the vehicle, later identified as the suspect, I smelt the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the passenger compartment. I asked the suspect if he had been drinking and he stated, "Too much." The suspect was asked from the vehicle and standard field sobriety tests were conducted. The suspect failed all tests given to him. The suspect was then tested on a PBT and showed a breath alcohol level of .188% per 210 liters of breath. I then transported the suspect to the VCCC to test him on the BAC breath instrument. While enroute to the confinement center, the suspect became more aggressive and angry over being stopped and confinement. The suspect was cussing and yelling going to the jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I had the suspect turn his head away to keep him from spitting on me or hitting me with his head. The suspect then stated, "You're lucky that I didn't knee you in the face." I then asked the suspect to get out of the vehicle, but he refused. I slowly assisted him, but he kept pulling away. Once outside the vehicle and when walking to the booking door, the suspect dropped his weight to the floor causing us both to fall forward. I injured my leg and tore a pair of pants at the knee. I controlled the suspect until confinement officers could assist me with restraining the suspect. The suspect was read the implied consent warning again at the confinement center and he refused. Also present at the house was Savannah's boyfriend, Sha'Corey Hawkins (he does not live there); there were two black females there that arrived in the vehicle that was in the middle of the street - they arrived with Kayla's baby-daddy Arterreous Milan. Milan was in another vehicle with two other black males but they had left the area before I arrived. I got everyone to stop screaming and sent the two females back to their vehicle so I could talk to everyone separately but they drove off before I finished with Kayla. Kayla told me that Milan is her baby's father but paternity has not been established in court. She said he is very violent and abusive and she decided that she was ending the relationship last month after he assaulted her again (1508264, 04/21/15). She said he will not leave her alone and calls and texts her every day, usually threatening her and others at her home. She said he was doing the same thing tonight and he showed up at her home with several subjects, apparently after Hawkins for something they were arguing about. She said he jumped out of the car he was in and immediately went after Hawkins and when Savannah stepped between them to try to keep them from fighting, she got hit by Milan. Kayla said she had to arm herself with a crowbar to keep the group at bay until police could get there. I gave her the case number for this incident as well as for the battery from 04/21 and she plans to go tomorrow morning to get a restraining order. I told her to save any text messages from him and to call if anyone shows up again tonight and that I would give the residence extra patrol.
