Dispatched to 620 East Delaware reference to a 911 Hang-up. Prior to arrival dispatched received a call from the neighbors stating the residents at 620 East Delaware were having an argument.

I arrived on scene and spoke with the Suspect. He stated they were having an argument about the children not being disciplined. They have one small child together and Jannie has 3 children of her own.

The Suspect states they were just arguing and nothing more. He said they are always having fights because she is not being tough enough on the kids.

I then spoke with Jannie and she stated they were having an argument and he was putting her down and also the kids. She stated she is tired of it. She states he bit her left cheek and also head butted her. I talked with her and told her I did not see any marks on her cheek or her head. She stated he just nipped her. She just wanted him to leave at this point and not come back.

She showed me a bruise on her right arm and stated this happened yesterday. The suspect saw her showing me the arm and then started yelling "make sure you tell him the whole story." He continued talking from the porch and stated that she tried to hit him and he grabbed her arm. I talked with her about this and she stated that yesterday he was yelling at her and up in her face and she did try to swing at him. And that is when he grabbed her arm.

She stated she has bruises on her chest and she was not sure if they happened today or yesterday. I asked if they were visible and she was not sure. At this point she just wanted him to leave and she was going to get a restraining order.

I spoke with the suspect and talked with him about getting some things and leaving. We started to head inside and get some things but Jannie wanted to go in first to use the restroom. This started another argument. It was at this point Jannie stated she wanted to press charges. We let her go inside first and use the restroom.

Myself and the suspect then went inside and he gathered a few things and prepared to leave. While inside he was talking with his mother in Gary Indiana about her coming down to get him. According to the suspect the mother has come down to get him before. I talked with him about maybe this time was the time they needed to stay apart for good. He agreed. I told him not to come back here without calling the police first. He stated that was fine and wanted my name so I could make the return trip. He gathered a few things and then left

I went back outside and started this report. This was approximately 20 minutes after I had last talked with Jannie. I was getting more information from her and she asked if I could see it now. Pointing to her cheek where she was bit. I looked and was unable to see anything. I had her turn her face and I looked straight on and then was able to see a very faint bruise on her cheek. The bruise appeared to be in the shape of a mouth. I called crime scene for some pictures. After about 10 more minutes it did appear a little more. The skin was not broke but you could see some bruising.

Crime Scene also photographed her upper right arm. This was the incident from yesterday. She also showed us some bruising from her chest area. That was also photographed. She stated those bruises happened today. Crime Scene also gave her a number to call in case the bruises get more noticeable.

I gave Jannie a case number and told her she needs to go to the Prosecutors office in the next couple of days if she wants to follow through on the charges. I

She said he is very violent and abusive and she decided that she was ending the relationship last month after he assaulted her again (1508264, 04/21/15). She said he will not leave her alone and calls and texts her every day, usually threatening her and others at her home. She said he was doing the same thing tonight and he showed up at her home with several subjects, apparently after Hawkins for something they were arguing about. She said he jumped out of the car he was in and immediately went after Hawkins and when Savannah stepped between them to try to keep them from fighting, she got hit by Milan. Kayla said she had to arm herself with a crowbar to keep the group at bay until police could get there. I gave her the case number for this incident as well as for the battery from 04/21 and she plans to go tomorrow morning to get a restraining order. I told her to save any text messages from him and to call if anyone shows up again tonight and that I would give the residence extra patrol.
