As soon as Owens exited the vehicle, I was able to see in plain view an uncapped syringe with a dirty looking fluid inside in the seat where Owens had just been sitting. AMR then noticed swollen and bloodied area inside the right elbow of Owens that I know from my training and experience to be the location often used for intravenous drug usage. When Owens was asked what the substance inside the syringe was, he answered "most likely heroin." Eventually, Owens admitted that he had an opiate and heroin addiction and that he had "shot up" just this morning.
