Minton`s complexion was extremely white and at first appeared highly intoxicated. Officers called off on an investigation at Washington Ave and Grand Ave. Robertson advised that her mother Minton was alright and that they were headed to the bank. Minton could not stand and almost hit her head on the sidewalk several times while Robertson was trying to pull her back to her feet. Officers looked more closely at Minton and her pupils were extremely large and she was barely breathing. Minton was unable to speak while we were asking her questions. We asked Robertson if Minton had taken anything, she advised no that Minton had hit her head about a week ago and had been suffering from the head injury ever since. Against what Robertson wanted, officers called for an ambulance and advised Robertson to leave Minton alone until the ambulance got there. Robertson argued with officers that her mother did not need an ambulance that they needed to get to the bank. She advised that once they made it to the bank she would then call for an ambulance. While we were talking to Robertson; Mintons condition got worse, her breathing became slower and she lost consciousness. Officer Pierce advised dispatch to tell AMR to step it up. Minton then stopped breathing and she had no pulse. Officer Pierce grabbed his Res-cue mask and started CPR on Minton. As Officer Pierce grabbed his CPR mask, Robertson left her mother and went into the bank. Officer Pierce yelled at her to stay on scene, but she continued into ONB. AMR # 1959 along with EFD arrived shortly after and they took over treating Minton. After they worked on Minton for several minutes AMR and EFD were able to get a pulse from Minton.
