Officers Harrington and Delano were the first to arrive and heard a female yelling "get off me" from inside. They knocked and made contact, then cuffed the male suspect. The victim, Gwaltney has children with the suspect. She has lived with him off and on for years but has only been staying at this address with the suspect for a couple months. She did not want to tell officers what happened at first. She said she was not injured badly and just wanted to leave. She started to try to call friends and family to have a place to stay. She was unable to make contact by phone I, Officer Fair offered to take her to a friends house, so she packed her things in my car. While doing so, she and the suspect started arguing. The suspect mentioned something about having weed. Gwaltney admitted they both had weed and handed it over to officers. see 15-12328 for that report. Both were given a citation. The suspect said something to make Gwaltney angry before we left, so she changed her mind and said she wanted to press charges. Gwaltney was transported to a friend's house. While enroute she told what happened tonight. She said the suspect accused her of cheating when a male neighbor was at their apartment to talk. Gwaltney told the suspect he was being irrational and tried to get away from him. He pushed her back in the room and tried to hold her down on the bed and then down on the ground. He put his hand over her mouth and she bit him. He punched her in her upper thigh and she showed the early signs of a bruise. She said it hurt. Officers arrived before she was injured any more than that. She was given a case number and advised how to follow up. Gwaltney refused medical attention.</p>	FAIR, D. A.
