Parker grabbed what appeared to be a large sum of money, and possibly other items, from his pockets / waistband and threw it into the driver's window, to his girlfriend, as he ran past the vehicle. He continued to run North - Northwest towards the North side of the apartment complex. Parker was apprehended a short time later.  It was later learned Parker threw a large sum of money into the vehicle, but no narcotics were located. A female Officer searched the girlfriend and a large sum of money was located in her sensitive areas. It was possible that narcotics were	
		hidden inside of her body, but non were located.  She stated they had been arguing and she dropped Parker off at his mother's residence, located at Kennedy Towers. She stated the argument never became physical.
