I, Officer Gibson, was in a fully marked patrol car and in full uniform was driving through the lot of KC's Timeout Lounge when a waitress, J.T., flagged me down. As I exited the vehicle J.T. said "that guy just punched her in the face". The victim, A.B., stated she didn't want to press charges and walked back into the bar. I approached the suspect, J.B., and asked for his ID. While speaking with J.B. he became very agitated, increasingly angry, and yelling. J.B. began threatening me saying that he was going to fight me. I then asked for additional units to respond.

I was on my portable radio running J.B. over Info through dispatch making sure he didn't have any warrants. While waiting for Info to respond I began asking J.B. what his current address was. J.B. stated to me "I live". I told J.B. that I didn't understand what that meant and that I just needed an updated address for him. J.B. stated that it didn't matter where he lived because he knew he was about to go to jail. I asked J.B. why he thought he was going to jail. J.B. stated that I knew why and nodded his head. I told J.B. that I didn't know why and asked him to tell me. J.B. then stated that he was on probation. I asked J.B. what he was on probation for and how long he has been on probation. J.B. said he just got out 60 days ago for dealing K2. I explained to J.B. I would let him leave as long as he didn't have any warrants and asked him again where he lived. J.B. said "you wanna know where I live?", I replied yes I need your address. J.B. stated Γll show you where I live. J.B. then took his hat off and threw it on the ground. J.B. was wearing a sling on his left arm, he took that off and threw it on the ground. J.B. then took his shirt off, threw it on the ground, pounded the right side of his chest with his right fist and said "that's where I live!". J.B. has "west side" tattooed across his chest, so I asked J.B., you live on the westside? J.B. stated "no nigga, I live that life!". I told J.B. that I didn't know what that meant and I still needed an address. J.B. said something along the lines of fuck you, we about to fight. That is when two working security guards, F.G. and J.S. stepped closer and said something along the lines of no man, you're not about to fight a lady cop. J.B. took a fighters stance and was had his right fist back and winding it like he was ready to punch. I kept my distance from J.B. while trying to talk him down. J.B. kept circling me and I countered all of his movements by circling with him. J.B. said several times come on cop we about to fight. I told J.B. that he needed to sit down for me and no one is fighting anyone. J.B. kept his fighting stance and stated that we were fighting. I told J.B. I didn't want to fight him and he needed to sit down for me. That is when more units arrived to assit. After the units arrived J.B.'s wife (A.B., the victim) grabbed him by his arms and sat him down on the sidewalk.

While other units were speaking with J.B. I walked A.B. off to the side to talk about her about J.B. punching her. A.B stated that she did not want to press charges and that it was ok because J.B. wouldn't remember any of it in the morning. By this time A.B.'s right had bruising and a contusion below as well as above her eye. A.B. was holding an ice pack to her eye and I explained to A.B. that her eye was starting to swell. A.B. said she didn't care and that he won't remember in the morning so it's ok.

I then spoke to the waitress, J.T., that originally flagged me down. J.T. stated that
