Melchiors said she was in an argument with a man and he pointed a gun at her. Dispatch told me she just called 911, told them a man in a black truck threatened her, was intoxicated and just left the lot.

Melchiors was difficult to talk to at first. She was visibly upset and rattled. She began telling me all kinds of irrelevant info when asked what happened. She even told me about past visits to the store. Eventually she said she got into an argument with another customer (suspect) in the parking lot over a statement made by the suspect about the donut delivery man, who was also on the lot. Before the suspect left he pointed his finger at Melchiors like a gun and said he ought to shoot her right between the eyes. She felt threatened and called 911. She said the man left in his truck north on St. Joseph. It had to be the one I saw because it was the only vehicle north on St. Joseph. Melchiors said she did not hear the shots. She may have been inside the store at the time.

Melchiors said the truck was a 2013 or newer silver/bronze Chevy 4dr truck with a black plastic wing of some sort coming off the rear of the cab. She began to give a description a the male but got distracted and all I discerned was a white male. There will be video of the suspect, but Thorntons management will have to get it later on dayshift.

Thorntons staff did not witness the act of intimidation, but did confirm Melchiors and the suspect shared unkind words and they confirmed the color of the truck. Melchiors was given a case number and told how to follow up.

Sgt. Thompson and I went to the area I saw the truck north on St. Joseph to look for empty casings. We found three 9mm shell casings in the road and on the sidewalk in front of 1001 N St. Joseph, confirming the shots came from the driver of the truck. The truck was passing that spot when I heard the shots. Crime scene detective Hamner collected them.
