Teer's friend stated suspect did not wake up until after Teer arrived at 421 Richardt home. Teer's friend stated Teer came to his home only once but Teer stated that was a lie.

Teer's neighbors stated they only saw one female near the apartment but she went to another apartment number with a dog. This female lives with Teer's friend at 421 Richardt and she stated the suspect never left the home. Police spoke with the suspect who stated she did not take anything and had been home all day. The suspect called the lost phone and Teer picked up.
