Columbia in reference to a battery report. When I arrived, I met with Erica and Brandon Sanders. They had been in an altercation with their landlord, Haider. Before leaving the property, the Sanders told me Haider and his girlfriend "Heather" (last name unknown) cut the power and AC to the apartment. They phoned police and were told the incident was civil in nature; however, they said they were told that it would be a good idea to document anything that violated the contract/lease. The Sanders went to the rear of the apartment building where their electrical box and unit run into the house and began taking pictures and video of where it appeared the electric was shut off and there were fuses removed from the AC unit. During that time, the tenant came out of apartment B, Andrew Banister and his acquaintance Cheatem. They told me Banister began shouting and swinging a piece of wood at Brandon while he was trying to get the power turned back on. Brandon told me Banister backed him all the way back to the alley by swinging what he described as a 2x4. Erica said she continued to film the incident. Erica said Cheatem was outside during the altercation, as well. Initially, Erica believed Cheatem was trying to contain Banister; however, as she filmed, Erica said Cheatem came after her and pushed her down. She also said Cheatem grabbed her by the hair. There was no visible sign of injury. Erica was filming the incident as Cheatem walked up to her, but the video shut off as Cheatem approached Erica's person. According to the Sanders, Banister does some odd jobs about the property and receives a discounted rent. Banister said Haider told him that the couple was not allowed to be in the rear of the property, so he was trying to keep them out of the back yard. It was explained to Banister that he cannot prevent people from being on property they legally rent. Banister was somewhat combative with officers. Cheatem was more cooperative. She did admit to battering Erica, but initially said she thought she was pushed. Later, she could not recall if she was pushed or not. She said she did push Erica down and grab her by the hair. Brown, was dispatched to Wal-Mart west in reference to a female shoplifter in custody. When I arrived, I was met by Loss Prevention employees. Seated in the office was Johnson and her infant daughter. Wal-Mart employee, Freeman, said he observed Johnson in the craft area acting suspiciously and he began observation of the female. Johnson began concealing several items in the lower compartment of her baby stroller, under where the baby was placed. She selected multiple items throughout the store and tucked them into various areas of the stroller and under blankets contained on the stroller. Johnson then went to the register where she paid for some of the said items; however, she did not produce all the concealed items to be scanned. She failed to pay for a two pack of jumbo space bags and a small jar of "chive" spice. Johnson then passed all points of purchase and the EAS towers prior to being apprehended by Freeman and other Wal-mart loss prevention employees. Johnson was recognized by Parris Ramsey, who had previously dealt with Johnson at the Princeton Wal-mart (from where she had been barred for a previous shoplift). Johnson was escorted to the office after being somewhat confrontational with employees. I arrived and began searching Johnson's person. While I was speaking with Wal-Mart employees, Johnson kept saying that she didn't mean to steal the items. Johnson was in possession of a set of car keys. I asked her if she had a vehicle in the lot, to which she replied that she did not. Johnson was somewhat combative in her reply regarding the vehicle. It was unclear if Johnson had any more children with her or if there were any others in her party, but she was clearly uncomfortable that I asked her about a vehicle. I went to my patrol vehicle to confirm Johnson's identity, as she was not in possession of a driver's license. I was able to do so with the assistance of EPD records. I was supplied a picture of Johnson's driver's license photo. While making contact with records, Freeman approached my vehicle and advised he found surveillance images of Johnson driving a vehicle to Wal-Mart. I asked Freeman why she gave false information regarding driving to Wal-Mart. She then told me that the vehicle didn't belong to her and she didn't want to get it towed. Upon running the registration, I determined the vehicle actually did belong to Johnson. Again, she said she didn't know why she lied about that either. Johnson was cited for false reporting and shoplift. She said she didn't mean to steal the items from Wal-Mart, but that she has a "problem."
