On the listed date and approximate time, officers were dispatched to N US 41 and Yokel Rd reference to a hit and run traffic accident where the victim was injured. Upon arrival, I, Officer Hastings, spoke to the victim who pointed out the suspect, Jessica Caswell, who had just exited a motel room at the Motel. The victim identified her by her clothing and physical description. I went to the area where I last saw the suspect and found her hiding in a stairwell. I detained the suspect at that time and found the suspect vehicle(IN WLE235) parked on the north side of the motel. I asked the suspect for her name and ID card. The suspect stated she didn't have an ID and when going through her purse, the suspect suddenly stood up and took off running to the southeast of the complex. I gave chase yelling for the suspect to stop and continuing to identify myself as a police officer. I caught up to the suspect and used the necessary force to take the suspect into custody. The suspect then began complaining of pain to her head, neck and lower abdomen. AMR#1180 transported the victim to my location where the victim again positively identified the suspect as the driver in the traffic accident. AMR#0956 transported the suspect to Deaconess hospital for medical evaluation. After being cleared from the hospital, I transported the suspect out to the Vanderburgh Co Confinement Center without incident.

After leaving the jail and continuing patrol, I was contacted by the jail Sgt that the suspect's sister, Jennifer Caswell, had called and stated her twin sister had falsely used her name when we arrested her. It was later determined that the suspect, Jessica Caswell, had lied and gave false information during the investigation. All paperwork was corrected and resubmitted.
