stolen. D.Thomas said the suspect is her boyfriend that she broke up with last week. She said he walked up to her car in the parking lot as she arrived at work today, just before 1600 hrs. The suspect took the keys from D.Thomas and drove off in the car without using any force. She said the suspect was alone. D.Thomas said she did not call the police at the time because she did not want to be late to clock-in for work. She did not call the police after she clocked in because she did not think she could use her phone. She did not tell a manager or anyone else about the incident until after 2100 hrs when she got a text from C.Payne, a friend of the suspect. Payne said he was with the suspect earlier when they had a wreck in the car. He said he was at Deaconess ER to be checked out. D.Thomas said her purse and documents inside were the only things of value in the car. All the necessary info was taken from her and she was given a case number. Two managers at Wal Mart were made aware of the incident. They said they would have their IT personnel try to find the incident in the parking lot on surveillance video and save it for crime scene.

I went to Deaconess ER and spoke to Payne. Sgt. Hildebrandt was with me. Payne was with his mother, T.Anderson. Payne said he and the suspect got the car from D.Thomas with her consent. He showed Hildebrandt texts saved on his phone indicating it was arranged for he and the suspect to have the car. He said he was the passenger in the car when the suspect wrecked it somewhere off of Washington on the east side. He said the suspect ran away from the scene because he did not have a license. D.Thomas and her father J.Thomas arrived at the ER also because one of their family members was involved in a separate incident. They heard what Payne had to say and said he was lying. Anderson seemed surprised at our conversation. She said Payne called her and asked to be picked up at a friends house. He had a swollen/bruised hand and asked her to take him to the ER. Payne has obviously not told his mom of all the events leading up to this point.

I spoke to J.Thomas. He explained that he had an incident with the suspect and Payne last week at Mikes Car Wash. He said he told the boys that day they were not allowed to ever be in his car, the red Pontiac in question. Payne and Anderson left the ER without being seen be ER staff because they were afraid there was going to be a problem with the Thomas family.

I left the ER and checked with dispatch to see if the car had been reported in an accident. At 1709 hrs an accident was reported in the 6400 block of Newburgh Rd. Officers found the car abandoned off the road and it was towed by Tri-State towing to their property.
