even without doing any work to earn it. She stated she cleaned, but could not remember where and stated she never answered a phone call. When asked how she received the check from the incident on today's date, when the involved other was already in custody, she was hesitant and stated she found it with her name on it.

Officers contacted the local pain management clinic and spoke with an employee. They advised they had changed their company name approximately 3 months prior and had no knowledge of an employee named Erica Negoski.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, Officers had reason to believe Negoski knowingly attempted to deliver / cash fraudulent checks, knowing they would not be honored by the financial institution in which the company was secured with. Simpsons's Food Fair, identified as a victim, was responsible for the loss of the money.

During a search incident to arrest, a black / yellow glass smoking device was located in her purse. The device contained a burnt residue consistent with that of burnt marijuana.

Negoski was arrested, transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center and charged with felony check deception and misdemeanor possession of paraphernalia.
