St. Vincent de Paul

St. Ben's Vincentians rely upon the providence of God. About a year ago, after the funeral of a long-time St. Ben's parishioner, her 4 children each made substantial memorial gifts to St. Ben's and asked Fr. Godfrey to use their gifts in memory of Mom's care and concern for the homeless. Fr. Godfrey entrusted their memorial gifts to St. Ben's St. Vincent de Paul Society. At about the same time, a 43-year-old single Mom (let's call her "Mariah") and her 17-year-old son (let's call him "Daniel") left a good job and all of their possessions behind to flee from an abusive relationship in East St. Louis, Illinois. Mariah had relatives here, but her relatives were poor folks themselves, and they couldn't take Mariah and Daniel into their own home. So Mariah and Daniel took shelter at the Ozanam Family Shelter on Read Street in Evansville. During their recovery, Mariah found a job. On Friday, April 1 Mariah took a leap of faith with Daniel, moved out of the Ozanam Family Shelter and into an apartment in St. Ben's Parish. The folks at Ozanam called St. Ben's Conference of SVdeP and asked if we could help Mariah and Daniel get settled in their new, but *empty* apartment. We made a home visit to Mariah and Daniel the following day. Before the end of that day with about \$800 of the money Mom's kids entrusted to Fr. Godfrey, St. Ben's Vincentians gave Mariah a voucher to purchase a sofa, a love seat, a queen-size bed for Mariah, a full-size bed for Daniel, bedding, a kitchen table and 2 chairs, a couple of tables and lamps, and a microwave oven; we even had it delivered to their second-floor apartment. In his providence, God connected the dots from Mom and her generous kids to Fr. Godfrey, Ozanam Family Shelter, Mariah, Daniel and St. Ben's SVdeP Society. Good ole God!

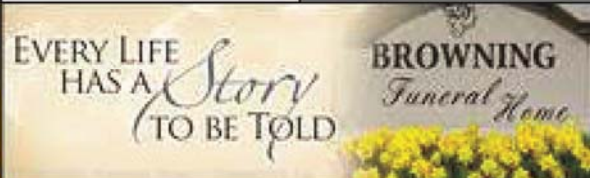
