I observed a red 1998 Pontiac Firebird to have heavy fire damage near the gas tank and rear of the vehicle.</p> <p>The RP, Larry Pope, advised he lived at 737 E. Iowa Street. He saw the vehicle on fire and ran over to 750 E. Virginia Street. He banged on the doors until WI #1, Lajeanna Neaveill, answered the door. Lajeanna ran out to the car and observed a cloth stuffed into the gas tank of the vehicle. The fire spread from the gas tank to the rear of the vehicle. The left rear quarter panel was damaged and half of the rear bumper and trunk area was melted.</p> <p>Shortly after I arrived on scene, IO #1, Aaron Neaveill, also arrived and was extremely agitated. He stated he knew who did it because he had an ongoing dispute in regards to parts on the car, including an expensive front hood. Initially, Aaron accused IO #3 R.B. of damaging the vehicle. Later, he stated IO #4, J.G. could have damaged the vehicle because she called the police on him yesterday during a dispute. Aaron was confrontational with me and EFD while he was on scene. He was extremely upset about the vehicle and had to be told multiple times to stay away from it while the investigation was being conducted.</p> <p>IO #2, Grover Neaveill, advised he had video footage of the possible suspect. I watched the video with EFD Fire Investigator, E. Eifert. I observed a female riding a dark colored scooter enter the frame. She was wearing a sock hat, jacket and distinctive "Ugg" style boots. She appeared to stop near the car, pause, and then continue south on Linwood Avenue. Once she got to the intersection of Linwood Avenue/Virginia Street, she stopped and looked back for a few seconds. Pope entered the scene and started banging on the doors of the residence. The female on the scooter left south on Linwood Avenue once Pope entered the scene. Aaron was adamant that the female on the scooter was J.G. He had a dispute with her yesterday and she called the police on him.</p> <p>I went to J.G.'s residence with Officer J. Delano and Officer M. Harrington. We made contact with J.G. and her parents. I spoke with J.G. on the front porch while Officer J. Delano and Officer M. Harrington spoke with her parents inside the residence. J.G. was familiar with Aaron and acknowledged they had an incident with police involved yesterday. However, she denied damaging Aaron's car and stated she had been sleeping since approximately 10:00pm. I observed J.G. to have bags under her eyes and she appeared to had just woke up after sleeping for a while.
