Things continued by text until around 3am when she showed up at his house causing problems and refusing to leave.</p> <p>When asked why he didn't call the police he stated because he has been in trouble quite a bit in the past and was just hoping she would leave.</p> <p>Evidently Candice stayed at or around the house from 3am till I was called and around 0630. Not sure of all of the events during this time frame but the suspect states she refused to leave and was harassing him the entire time. The suspect also stated the daughter is 19 years of age.</p> <p>According to the suspect, he is trying to get her to leave and she is wanting money for a coke. She is sitting in the driver seat of the car at this time. He goes and gives her money for a coke hoping she will leave. Another argument takes place and she throws the money back at him. He says the driver side door is open and he reaches down to pick up the money. When he did this she pulled the door shut on him several times. He states he got mad and pushed the driver door back. This door is possibly bent but it looked closed when Candice sped away. (Candice was mad cause I wasn't taking him to jail). After he gets up from the door beating he turns around and sees where she has keyed the passenger side bed of his truck. In addition she has kicked the passenger side door.
