When I arrived, the VI (Hunt) stated that sometime after midnight a vehicle had hit his 1990 Chevy vehicle that had been parked in his yard next to the road. There was numerous pieces of debris around the Chevy vehicle and a noticeable trail of fluid headed south. Hunt was advised to hold onto the beige or gold colored piece of debris that likely came from the suspect vehicle. Judging by the direction of travel and areas hit, the damage to the suspect vehicle would likely be to the front-right of the vehicle. As I attempted to follow the trail of fluid I could see several mailboxes that had freshly been damaged along the way that the suspect vehicle had apparently traveled. The suspect vehicle appeared to travel south until S Burkhardt Rd dead-ends then veering to the west through yards and eventually up Rosemarie where other mailboxes and yards were damaged. A resident at 1337 S Burkhardt Rd is said to have exterior surveillance cameras according to a nearby neighbor. The resident of 1337 S Burkhardt Rd was not able to be reached. Victims at 1009 S Burkhardt Rd and 1312 Rosemarie Ave were added to the report for damage to mailboxes and other items.
