His brother got upset because some of his property was missing so he grabbed the bag out of David's hand and "assaulted him". He claimed he is disabled and there are "laws protecting that".

I then spoke with the suspect. He stated that he is power of attorney over David and his mother [including all decisions about property and residences] The suspect advised that David got on him about several things and then demanded his keys and items in the suspects safe that belonged to him. David confronted the suspect when he arrived at their mothers home and demanded the property. He advised he handed David the property but David refused to give him his garage door opener, citing he never had it. Timothy admitted to "snatching" the bag out of David's hand but advised he never laid a hand on him.

David then spoke to Officer Porter and Sgt. Rahm [whom David requested as he was not satisfied with officers answers] and his story varied. Now he was stating that when the suspect took the bag out of his hand, the suspect shoved David, causing him to twist his ankle. David went on to say that it did not hurt though.

David demanded a report and was provided with a case number.
