Toral and R. Pylant were working off duty at the Arbor`s apartments when we observed short term traffic coming in and out of the entry way of 1527-1533 Savannah Dr., building 10. This is usually indicative of narcotics activity and the Arbors is in a high narcotics trafficking area. Officers surveilled the apartment for several more minutes, then decided to investigate.  Officers later entered the enclosed entry way and first encountered Keenan (IO#2), who was trying to leave through the rear entrance. Officers observed that the hallway was completely engulfed with the smell of burnt marijuana. Torn corner baggies, blunt guts, and burnt incense ashes were on the floor as well. Off. Toral began interviewing Keenan, as I tried to locate the source of the burnt marijuana. Keenan advised Off. Toral that he did have a gun on him and has a permit to carry. This was later confirmed through records. Off. Toral held the gun until we concluded our investigation. Keenan stated that he was here visiting a friend, known as "Shaq" at 1531. Coincidentally, this was the same apartment where the burnt marijuana smell was coming from. I knocked on 1531 several times, in which eventually "Shaq" opened the door, exited, and closed it immediately behind him. "Shaq" was later identified as Shachia (IO#1) Shachia stated that he had some friends over visiting, but did not know who was smoking marijuana. I asked who was in his apartment, in which he stated just a couple guys and two girls. I asked if I could open his door and have them step out, in which he agreed. When I opened the door, you could smell burnt incense and marijuana coming from inside. In the front room were three males. I asked for all of them to come out and stand in the hallway, in which they complied. I then asked Shachia if I could go in his apartment to see if anyone else was inside, in which he consented. Inside were several more people throughout the apartment and all were asked to step outside. Moreover, throughout Shachia`s apartment, I observed several torn corner baggies, blunt guts in an ashtray, incense, and whole sandwich bags lying on the floor and kitchen table, all in plain view. I did not actually see any marijuana in plain view.  Once officers completed running everyone for warrants and interviewing each, officers advised all subjects that they would be barred from all Arbor`s property for 10 years, due to suspicion of consuming and engaging in narcotics trafficking.
