Gold stated that her boyfriend, Armstead, had come upstairs to her apartment and hit her in the head, choked, and raped her repeatedly for the past two hours (0030 to 0230). Gold stated that she and Armstead have been in a relationship for the past three years but had recently broken up. Gold was asked if she needed an ambulance and she stated, "No, I can't afford to go to the hospital." I then explained to Gold we would need to go to the hospital to get a Rape Kit complete and she stated she did not want to go. I did not observe any marks on Gold head, face, or neck that would substantiate her story. Gold's apartment did not appear to be in disrepair based on what she was describing.  As I spoke to Gold, I could smell an odor of alcohol on her breath and her speech was slurred. Gold admitted to drinking a "half a pint" earlier in the evening. There were also several beer cans in the trash and on the floor of the apartment.  We then spoke to Armstead who stated that he had brought over his new baby, which he had with another woman, to see Gold. Armstead stated Gold became violent and began hitting him so he went downstairs to apartment A where he has been staying with his daughters. Armstead told me he got to the apartment around midnight and had been there ever since leaving Gold's apartment.  We spoke with Armstead's daughters, both listed as Involved Others. Both daughters stated that Armstead had gotten to the apartment between 2300 and 2400 hours and had not left prior to our arrival.  Detective Arbaugh was called to the scene and spoke to Gold and Armstead. Det. Arbaugh told me that after speaking with Gold that he did not see any injuries to her and that Gold did not want to go to the hospital for the state kit, or to press charges. Det. Arbaugh added that Gold only wanted a report to be taken.  Armstead was released from custody and told to stay away from Gold for the rest of the evening.		KLEIN, P. T.
