A medium-sized, partially blind-looking dog was protecting Mr Steinkamp and would not allow me to do much more than check Mr Steinkamp for a pulse. I requested an ambulance and someone from Animal Control.

EFD responded as well as AMR ambulance #1959 and Animal Control.

The dog was controlled by a dog stick and placed in the bathroom of the home. Ms Richter advised that a neighbor routinely takes care of the dog whenever Mr Steinkamp goes into the hospital and, per their request, the dog was left at the scene.

According to both Ms Ambrose and Ms Richter, Mr Steinkamp has an extensive medical history. He was eventually transported from the home to St Vincent's Hospital for treatment.

Ms Ambrose and Ms Richter secured the home.
