She in turn gave him the cold shoulder. This seemed to upset the male. The male and his friend who was a taller black male got into a gold colored Ford Crown Victoria, and began circling the parking lot. When Miller thought that the two males had left, she felt she was safe to go ahead and drive home. While on her way home to 304 Cross St., she noticed that the gold Crown Vic was following her. She continued home, and pulled into her drive way. As she was about to exit her vehicle one of the males began to shoot a handgun firing several rounds. The males sped off heading east on Cross toward Governor. Miller stated that she had never seen either male before tonight, and noted that they both spoke with some kind of accent.</p> <p>Six spent shell casing were found on Judson St., by Miller`s drive way.
