On 10/14/17, the VI states that the OF used her card to make a purchase, or withdraw money from her account at the "Liquor Store" in the 1900 block of Covert Ave., in the amount of \$100.00, plus fees. On 10/15/17, the OF used her bank card to make a purchase, or withdraw money from her account at the "Kwik Stop" in the 1600 block of Pollack Ave., in the amount of \$200.00, plus fees. The VI advised that she has not given the OF permission to use her card and believes the OF had stole it during the times she was at her house and remembered her PIN number from previous trips the OF made with her to the bank. The VI states that the OF is the only one who has been helping her in such an intimate capacity.
