Sivils stated she was at the above address when her boyfriend, later identified as J. Hagenseiker, had gotten into an argument that became physical. Sivils stated at one point she was able to get away from Hagenseiker and ran to the fire station for help. Sivils advised Hagenseiker did have a gun on a table during the incident.</p> <p>Due to possibility of a firearm being involved, myself and officer McKinney attempted to make contact with Hagenseiker. Hagenseiker could be seen inside the house moving from room to room and turning off lights, but he refused to answer the door. Other officers arrived and secured the scene. Hagenseiker's mother arrived and was eventually able to get him to answer the phone and I was able to talk Hagenseiker out of the residence without any further incident.</p> <p>I asked Hagenseiker what was going on and he stated that he and Sivils have been involved in a "on again, off again" relationship for years due to accusations of infidelity. Hagenseiker stated he invited Sivils to the house tonight, cooked them dinner, and went upstairs to have sex. Hagenseiker elaborated that he and Sivils engage in "rough sex".</p> <p>Hagenseiker continued that during the sex, he tried to do something she didn't agree with and she told him it was turning her off. Hagenseiker said Sivils tried to continue having sex with him, but by this point he was no longer interested. Hagenseiker stated he and Sivils began verbally arguing, and she grabbed a loaded handgun that he keeps on his nightstand and pointed it at him. Hagenseiker stated he was able to knock the gun out of her hand at which point Sivils ran out of the house.</p> <p>I then went back to the fire station spoke to Sivils. Sivils told me she was invited over to Hagenseiker's house for dinner and the two eventually began having sex. Sivils also described the sex as rough, but added that at one point the sex became too rough for her liking, and she told Hagenseiker that it was starting to turn her off. Sivils stated Hagenseiker became upset and began yelling at her about not being turned on by him. Sivils added that Hagenseiker became so upset that she became afraid he might try to use the gun so she reached for the table to move it when Hagenseiker knocked it out of her hand.</p> <p>Sivils continued that she told Hagenseiker that she was going to leave and began gathering her belongings. Sivils stated Hagenseiker continued to yell at her and began pushing her down to the ground to keep her from leaving. Sivils advised Hagenseiker would block and close doors so she could not leave, and at one point closed a door on her head. Sivils stated she eventually was able to get outside to her car, but when she tried to close the door, Hagenseiker blocked it so she could not do so. Sivils continued that when she would put the car in gear, Hagenseiker would run behind it and prevent her from backing out. Sivils stated at this point she ran next door to the fire house and the firemen called 9-1-1.</p> <p>Sivils complained of pain to her head, and pointed out a small swelling behind her right ear. Sivils denied medical treatment. Hagenseiker was noted for a golf ball sized not to his left eyebrow, and multiple scratch marked down the left side of his back.
